Mineola ISD is having a free H1N1 shot/mist clinic for Mineola ISD students January 14, 2010 and January 18, 2010, from 12:00-6:00 p. m. at the Mineola Primary School Office.

Children through 9 years of age should get two doses of vaccine, about a month apart. You will be notified of the clinic for the second dose. Older children and adults need only one dose.

The mist will be available or the H1N1 injection. The mist is not recommended for anyone with a long-term health problem, asthma, anyone with certain muscle or nerve disorders that can lead to breathing or swallowing problems, or anyone in close contact with a person with a severely weakened immune system.

A parent signature along with legal name of student will be required for the vaccine administration. Students through fifth grade will need to have an adult present when the vaccine is given. Please provide the name of the person who will be present with your child below.

Turn in this paperwork by January 11, 2010 to the office at your student's campus so that the vaccine can be available for the clinics.
