All students attending Mineola ISD in the 2017-2018 school year are asked to register **online** at www.mineolaisd.net before the first day of school, August 17. **This includes returning students and children new to the district.** Computers will be available at the campuses Monday through Friday from 8:30 – 3:30 if needed.
